- Dogs must be kept on lead at all times (no extendable leads please).

** A shorter walk of 0.6 miles (approx. 1 km) checking in at 12.15pm and starting at 12.45pm from the Golf Club has been arranged for those with puppies or veteran dogs, or those who feel unable to tackle the full walk.
