Postal Entries must include payment with entry form, entry fees to be made by cheque, payable to SGRS or by BACS payee SGRS sort Code 30-92-86 A/C No. 00671862 for reference purposes when paying BACS please write FT by your full name. , payment for those who enter via FTMS System will be collected on the day proceeding the trial. If entering more than one dog please use a separate cheque or BACS payment for each dog.

Preference in the draw will be given to SGRS Members.

Definition of Novice Stake: A stake, which is confined to dogs that have not gained an award, which would qualify them for first preference in the draw for Open Stakes (Ref j7.i applies)

The draw will take place at 8.00pm on the 10th November 2018 at the above address.

Any member wishing to be present at the draw is invited to do so. All entrants will be notified via FTMS or email for the paper entries or by post if a stamped SAE is sent with the entry together with the time and place, Post Code of the meet.

The Draw will also be placed on the SGRS Facebook page.

Note: This will be a driven trial on Duck and Pheasants.

#### S.G.R.S. RULES (inclusive of Kennel Club Mandatory Rules)

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Field Trials must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
2. The Committee of the S.G.R.S. reserves the right to refuse any entry K.C. Rule J7.d
3. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
4. If entries or nominations exceed the number of permitted runners, the right to compete in a Trial shall be decided by ballot.
5. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the judges may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club.
6. No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of the Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.
7. Preference in the draw will be given to members dogs in their ownership. If a competitor enters more than one dog, the preferred dog must be clearly marked on the entry form.
8. The society will refuse any refund of entry fee for withdrawal within 7 days of the stake, with the exception of dogs withdrawn for veterinary reasons (Veterinary certificate will be required) and those that have qualified subsequent to the close of entries.
9. Substitution of dogs will not be allowed if there are sufficient runners present to fill the card
10. Please clearly fill in entry form and enter Kennel Club registration or Stud Book number or ATC number of dog
11. All persons attending the Trial will be under the control of the Chief Steward; they must be dressed appropriately and conduct themselves according to shooting field practices and traditions.
12. The S.G.R.S. cannot accept responsibility for injury, loss or damage to persons, dogs or property however, caused.

13. Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.

14. Videography and photography will only be permitted with the express permission of the Chief Steward and the host.

15. WELFARE OF DOGS. An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

16. DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. .If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

17. Dogs which are entered in a FT should be experienced in finding and retrieving game and any handler considering running their dog in a FT should attend several trials as a spectator first to be familiar with the KC Rules and Regulations which cover Field Trials.
