

New GDPR Requirements for SGRS Members

As we are all aware the new General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) came into effect on 25th May. We have all been inundated with e-notices and statements.

The new GDPR is principally aimed at big trading organisations send marketing material but even clubs, such as ours, that are categorised as "not for profit" organisations, have to enter into the spirit of the regulations.

Accordingly the SGRS has now put in place a Data Privacy Notice and Retention Policy that can be viewed here

There will also be additional clauses to many of the standard SGRS forms. You are urged to read these documents which inform you of your rights as a Data Subject.

For SGRS members there is no need to give "positive consent" as we are not a commercial organisation or do direct marketing for any other organisation. We only hold your data for appropriate "Contractual Necessity and/or Legitimate Interest" purposes based on the fact that you originally gave your details to be a SGRS member in order to be contacted regarding newsletters, event invitations and information about club events and meetings etc. In other words, your interest in the SGRS is NOT unsolicited as you applied and continue to be an SGRS member, so you do not need to give further permission.

We do not share your personal details with any other organisation or persons other than the Kennel Club (as and when required as a registered Society) and the SGRS Committee and Co-ordinators for legitimate SGRS business. We do not process your details for any other reason than legitimate SGRS business, nor do we publish your data in a yearbook nor on the website.

What is important though, is that you advise of any change of details (to address/email) as soon as possible so that the information the SGRS retains is accurate and up-to-date.
